

About EDF Energy



EDF Energy is the UK's largest producer of electricity. With a current installed capacity of around 16,500MW, we produce almost one-quarter of the nation's electricity from our nuclear, coal and gas power stations, as well as combined heat and power plants and wind farms.

We also deliver power to a quarter of the UK's population via our electricity distribution networks in London, the South East and the East of England and supply gas and electricity to over 5.5 million business and residential customers.

EDF Energy, which now incorporates British Energy, employs nearly 20,000 people across the UK.

We are one of the largest employers in the South West, with about 4,000 people working across the region. British Energy, as part of EDF Energy, owns and operate the Hinkley Point B power station.

Our parent company is EDF Group, an integrated energy operator present in all sectors of the electricity industry. We believe that the challenges of climate change and security of supply must be met by greater energy efficiency as well as a diverse mix of generating technologies including low carbon nuclear power, renewables, gas and clean coal.

As part of this, we plan to build four new nuclear plants in the UK, with the first operational by the end of 2017.
